Lawns

NEW LAWNS: Apply 20 pounds to 5,000 square feet (100' x 50'). Distribute evenly over the planting area and mix 2-3 inches into the soil prior to putting down seed or sod. See chart for spreader settings.

EXISTING LAWNS: Apply 20 pounds to 2,500 square feet (50' x 50'). Distribute evenly over the lawn area. See chart for spreader settings. Water lawn after application to start the greening process. Apply up to four times each year.

Gardens, Shrubs & Trees

GARDEN: Apply 5-10 pounds to 1,000 square feet and work into the soil to a depth of 3-4 inches before planting. Water thoroughly.

SHRUBS & BUSHES: Apply 1/4 pound (about 1/2 cup) for shrubs 3-4 feet across; apply uniformly under the shrub, then slowly water in until the soil is well saturated. Apply in early spring and again in early summer, after flowers have fallen off.

TREES: Measure 1/4 pound (about 1/2 cup) for each inch of trunk diameter. Distribute fertilizer evenly on the ground in a 3 foot wide circular path corresponding to the drip line of the tree. The drip line is the outer perimeter of the lower branches of the tree. Water thoroughly after application. Feed in the spring and fall.

Roses & Flowers

NEW ROSE PLANTS: Work 1/4 cup into the soil at the bottom of the planting hole. Cover with 1 inch of soil. Mix another 1/4 cup into the soil used to fill in around the roots.

FLOWER BEDS: Apply 5 pounds to 100 square feet of bed and work into the top 4-6 inches of soil before planting.

PERENNIALS: Apply 3 pounds to 100 square feet when spring growth begins. Water after fertilizing with a slow soaking that will thoroughly soak the soil to a depth of 16-20 inches.

SETTING YOUR LAWN SPREADER

THESE SETTINGS ARE A GUIDE. They were determined by landscape professionals using new spreaders. The condition of your spreader, your walking speed, the roughness of the lawn, and even the humidity can affect how fast the lawn food comes out. Watch the flow rate. If fertilizer appears to be coming out either slower or faster than you are covering the lawn, adjust the setting. Close the spreader when filling, turning or stopping.
