ALUDE Systemic Fungicide may be used for suppression of **Foliar and Basal Anthracnose** (*Colletotrichum graminicola*) on the following turfgrasses: annual bluegrass (*Poa annua* L.) and creeping bentgrass (*Agrostis palustris* Huds.).

DIRECTION FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. The following recommendations are made to permit the applications of this product on turf grass in accordance with FIFRA Section 2(ee)(2), which permits the use of pesticide products for control of pests not specifically cited on the label.

ALUDE Systemic Fungicide can be integrated into an overall disease and pest management strategy whenever the use of a fungicide is required.

ALUDE Systemic Fungicide is recommended for the suppression of **Foliar and Basal Anthracnose** when used alone and as part of a prevention and control program when tank mixed with other products registered to control this disease. Follow existing label instructions and apply this product as a foliar spray at a rate of 5.5 fluid ounces per 1,000 square feet in a minimum of 2 gallons of water (88 gpa). Repeat treatment on a 14 day schedule when environmental conditions are conducive for the development of disease. For best results, follow local extension service recommendations for application timing.

ALUDE is compatible in tank mixes with other fungicides that are registered for the control of Anthracnose. When tank mixing, observe all directions, precautions and limitations on the labeling of all products used.

This recommendation is made as permitted under FIFRA Section 2(ee) and has not been submitted to or approved by EPA. All applicable directions, restrictions and precautions on the EPA-registered label are to be followed. This bulletin must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide use.
