



Early Spring

February - April
Prevents crabgrass and other weeds while feeding your lawn. (In the Pacific Northwest, substitute Turf Builder® With Moss Control. For St. Augustinegrass, substitute Super Bonus® S Weed and Feed. For dormant bermudagrass, substitute Hats® Crabgrass Preventer.)

Late Spring

April - June
Kills dandelions and other broadleaf weeds while feeding your lawn. (For St. Augustinegrass, substitute Super Turf Builder®.)

Summer

June - August
Kills lawn damaging insects, fleas and Brown Dog ticks while feeding your lawn. For grub control, apply Scott's® GrubBe® Season-Long Grub Control anytime from April to mid-August.

Early Fall

August - November
The best time to feed for a thicker, greener lawn.

Late Fall

September - November
4 to 6 weeks after Early Fall Lawn Fertilizer feeding. Apply as last feeding in fall to help prepare your lawn for winter.



Directions for use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Application

- Apply to dry foliage. It is not necessary to water in after application.
- Apply this product in early Spring before the 4th mowing or before temperatures are regularly in the 80's (See Map). Rain, snow or freezing weather after application will not affect the performance of this product.
- Do not seed or sod for four growing months following application. This product can prevent seeds from germinating.
- On newly seeded or sodded areas, wait until grass has been mowed at least 4 times.
- Do not use on Dichondra or bentgrass lawns.
- Do not apply to shrubs, flower or garden seed beds or plants.
- Do not apply this product more than once a year. Allow at least 4-6 weeks between applications of any other product in this Program.
- Do not apply material to cement, stone, clothing or shoes. If contact occurs brush off particles to prevent staining. If necessary, rinse off with water.



Raking

You may rake your lawn lightly to remove grass clippings or debris. But avoid breaking the soil surface in your lawn for 4 months after application. Heavy raking will disturb the crabgrass barrier and reduce the effectiveness of this product.

Actively growing crabgrass or moss

This product does not control actively growing crabgrass, moss, or other existing weeds.

Staining note:

Can cause staining to cement, stone, metallic surfaces (such as automobiles and garden furniture), clothing, or shoes. If contact occurs, brush off particles to prevent staining and/or tracking into the house. If necessary, rinse off with water.


Spreading Tips

Apply header strips. Then apply product in longest direction of lawn. For best results, use a Scott's spreader.

Spreader Settings		DIRECTIONS
Scott's® AccuGreen® Drop Spreaders	5 1/4	Mow lawn first; apply 2 header strips; apply longest direction of lawn, overlapping wheel marks.
Scott's® PrecisionGreen® Drop Spreader	6	Mow lawn first; apply 2 header strips; apply longest direction of lawn, overlapping wheel marks.
Scott's® SpeedyGreen® & EdgeGuard® Rotary Spreaders	3 1/4	Make each pass about 5 feet from previous pass to overlap spread width.
Scott's® EasyGreen® Rotary Spreader	27	Make each pass about 30 inches from previous pass to overlap spread width.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS


