DIRECTIONS FOR USE

ESTABLISHED LAWNS: Apply 10-15 pounds of fertilizer per 1,000 square feet, broadcasting the fertilizer uniformly over the surface of the lawn, in the Spring, Summer, and again in the Fall. (Omit Fall application on Centipede lawns). Water the lawn thoroughly after applying fertilizer.

NEW LAWNS: Apply 12-17 pounds of fertilizer per 1,000 square feet, broadcasting the fertilizer uniformly over the soil and work the fertilizer lightly into the soil surface. After seeding, sprigging or sodding, water the lawn regularly until the grass is established.

FLOWERS AND VEGETABLES: Spread fertilizer evenly on the bed surface at the rate of 11/4 pounds per 100 square feet. Work into the top 2 to 3 inches of soil surface before planting. For vigorous growth, repeat every 6 weeks during the growing season, at the rate of 11/4 pounds per 100 square feet, working lightly into soil surface along rows or around plants.

SHRUBS AND HEDGES: Broadcast evenly 1 to 2 pounds of fertilizer for each 100 square feet of bed area under the spread of branches. Apply in Late-Spring and Early-Fall. Where more rapid growth is desired, or in areas where the growing season is extended, a third application is recommended in Mid-Summer. Scratch fertilizer lightly into the soil surface and water well.

SHADE TREES: Measure tree trunk diameter 4 feet above the ground. Weigh out fertilizer. For small trees (less than 6 inches in diameter), use 11/2 pounds of fertilizer for each inch in diameter. For large trees (over 6 inches in diameter), use 3 pounds of fertilizer for each inch in diameter. Scatter the fertilizer on the soil surface under the limb spread to slightly beyond the drip line, inward to a point 1 foot from the trunk of the tree. If the tree is growing in sod, place the fertilizer in 2 inch diameter holes, 12 inches deep. These holes should be spaced approximately 2 to 3 feet apart beneath the tree and under the drip line with no holes within 1 foot of the tree trunk. Divide fertilizer up into the holes. Fill holes with soil and press closed with foot. Feed in Early-Spring and repeat in Early-Fall.

UNITS OF MEASUREMENTS:

Normally a one pound coffee can holds about 2 pounds of fertilizer.

One level cup of fertilizer equals approximately 1/2 pound.

One pound of fertilizer per 100 square feet of bed area equals 1/4 cup per shrub.
